

# HOG BOX HOUSE

#### What you will need:

- -> Cardboard box (40cm x 30cm x 30cm)
- -> Scissors
- -> CD case
- -> Sellotape
- -> Pencils or crayons

- 1) Sellotape entire box up Well.
- 2) Use the CD case to as a template and cut a hole at the base of one corner.
- 3) Put dried leaves, hay, or straw inside the box.
- 3) Paint or draw little a little hedgehog on the box and don't forget to your name!



# HOG WINEBOX HOUSE

#### What you will need:

- -> Wine box
- -> Large log
- -> CD case
- -> Saw
- -> Dried leaves, hay, or straw

# -> Dried Leaves, hay, or s

#### Steps:

1) Use the CD case as a template and cut a hole in to the front of the Winebox

- 2) Fill the Winebox With dried leaves, hay, or straw.
- 3) Place a heavy log ontop of the box to keep it in place.



### HOG LOG HOUSE

What you will need:

- -> 30 logs (40cm long)
- -> Dried leaves, hay, or straw





- 1) Arrange the logs so that they are stacked with a large tunnel going through them.
- 2) Place dried leaves, hay, or straw inside.



## HOG BRICK HOUSE

#### What you will need:

- -> 17 Bricks
- -> Two wooden sheets (80cm x 60cm)
- -> Dried leaves, hay, or straw
- -> One large log





- 1) Place one Wooden sheet on the ground.
- 2) Stack the bricks on top of the Wooden sheet creating a nice space for the hedgehog to sleep and a small entrance tunnel.
- 3) Fill With dried leaves, hay, or straw.
- 4) Place the second wooden sheet on top with a heavy log to keep it in place.



# HOG FEEDING STATION

#### What you will need:

- -> Plastic tub With lid
- -> Saw
- -> CD case
- -> Two shallow bowls
- -> One large log

- 1) Use the CD case as a template and cut out the shape in to the side of the tub.
- 2) Place the tub upsidedown with a bowl of water and a bowl of hedeghog food inside it.
- 3) Put a large heavy log on top of the tub to keep it in place.
